Use gradations of charcoal and chocolate to make a sophisticated version. Our detailed full-color pattern includes lots of diagrams to guide you through every step. Skill Level: Intermediate

Develop your skills in applique as you create these darling figures under the guidance of quilt artist Sandra Sarner!

This class will teach participants how to prepare the zoo baby images for machine applique using double sided fusible to attach image sections to the block background. Principles of order of placement will be covered. The method used is transferable to any type of fabric image construction including landscapes, portraits, etc. and this will be explained and samples provided. There will also be some time spent after lunch illustrating three possible methods of machine applique to use to secure the images once they have been prepared.

Participants will have the choice of three different zoo baby animals to work on in class. Each person will also take home paper printouts of the other two zoo baby animals available.
